

SFI Business Builder Check List

Below is a list of things you need to do to get started – properly. Please take this VERY seriously. The best time to get things right from the outset is NOW!

1. **Ensure** you have mail@sfimg.com in your email address book, otherwise you will miss out on important news that I send out to my downline via the SFI mailer. This is absolutely critical to your success. Do it now!
2. **Update** your **Account Information** – otherwise to whom does SFI send commissions? No address, no PAY! Do it now. Note: where it says Postcode/Zip Code, if you are using a Post Office Box number in your address, also enter that **number** here (just the number!).
3. Your **Affiliate Profile** MUST be completed before you do anything, so that instead of landing on a boring Check List every time you log-on to sfimg.com, you will arrive on a page with IMPORTANT news regarding SFI. So do it now and get this out of the way (if you haven't already completed all of the tasks, it is the first page you see when you log-in).

How to Order Your SFI Mastercard Debit Card

Once again, an American company, Payoneer, assumes everything around the world works exactly the way it does in America. False! As regards the Payoneer Mastercard debit card issued on behalf of SFI, the problem is with the address! They (Payoneer) insist that you must not enter a *Post Office Box* address when ordering the debit card on their website ... that you must ONLY enter a *physical* address. Well, that's fine for America and Europe but it certainly doesn't work in *most* developing countries. In most of Africa, for example, your mail gets delivered to a P.O. Box. And that's it! There's no such thing as door-to-door mail delivery. At all! But hey, you try telling Payoneer that!

To help you surmount this minor setback, I've worked out a couple of viable solutions to the problem. Here's what to do...

SFI Works if You Do. Let's Build a Formidable Team. Together!

If you've already ordered your card using a physical address (with no P.O. Box) and your card hasn't arrived, log-in at Payoneer.com and speak to them via LIVE CHAT. Explain your predicament and have them resolve this problem. They can have the issued card cancelled, and they *can* include your P.O. Box number on your account for you and then send you a new card in the post. They've done this before. So I know for a fact that it **is** doable. Just explain to them clearly and they'll sort it out for you.

Ordering a new debit card? Here is a list of things you should do so that your card doesn't go missing in the post.

1. Do not make the mistake of ONLY including your physical address and leaving out your Post Office Box Number just because Payoneer say you should. If you do this, you will not receive your card! Simple logic really, there's no rocket science behind that. I've seen countless affiliates who's debit cards have gone missing in the post because they followed these misguided instructions.
2. At one time, to get around this, if you wrote your physical address followed by P.O. Box (and then your number), it worked. And then that got blocked by Payoneer! Out of the blue. The last time I checked, if you filled in your physical address followed by **Box** (and then your number), the system accepted your application. I don't know whether that still works, but it's sure worth a try.
3. And if it doesn't, you most definitely will get through if you have a local language that your Post Office understand refers to **P.O. Box** (like in Tanzania **S.L.P** – short for **Sanduku La Posta** or **Sanduku La Barua**), then you insert that as part of your address. For example, since they insist you must have a physical address, here's how to go about it. Let's say your address is 23 Market Street and that your P.O. Box is 2222. Here's what you enter – as in the Tanzanian example above: **23 Market Street, S.L.P 2222, Dar es salaam. Tanzania.** You see? They won't know S.L.P means P.O. Box. They don't speak Swahili!

I do hope this helps, and that it will reduce the number of complaints regarding this issue. If you have any questions, or have a card you've ordered that hasn't arrived because of this confusion, please contact me and I'll see what I can do to help.
